



ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT 2021

Allied Exploration & Geotechnics Limited (the Company) is fully committed in achieving a high level of environmental performance within the management and operation of its working practises. As an organisation predominantly involved in earth sciences we are wholly dedicated in promoting policies and procedures that protect the environment by reducing waste (by promoting recycling/recovery), preventing pollution and lowering our carbon footprint by minimising the use of energy, materials and natural resources.

The Company recognises and accepts its obligations set by relevant environmental legislative and regulatory guidance and strives to attain high standards in compliance with these statutory requirements and places a high value on its Duty of Care to the environment.

The Company has developed an Environmental Management System (EMS) complying with BS 14001:2015 to ensure the above is effectively adhered to. The EMS which includes this policy is subject to regular review by the Directors and Management to ensure objectives are being attained and that the company is compliant with current environmental regulations and that adequate resource is being allocated as part of the company's commitment to establish its sustainability goals. This in part is undertaken by setting clear objectives and targets as well as the establishment of key performance indicators. These are used to monitor and facilitate continual improvement and to implement strategic direction. The companies environmental policy will be actively promoted to all stakeholders and interested parties.

The Company recognises that the successful implementation of this Policy requires total commitment and constant cooperative effort from all of our employees. This will be facilitated and supported by a strong positive culture in the workplace environment. Through an environmental awareness programme all employees are to be trained to the highest standards to enable them to carry out their tasks in an environmentally sustainable manner. The HSEQ Director is responsible for co-ordinating and advising on all quality, safety, health and environmental matters including the implementation and review of this policy.
